# **TEACHING EXPERIENCE**

### East Carolina University, August 2019 - Present

ART-3280 - Concepts in Photography

This course investigates contemporary practices in photography and development of a concept-based body of artwork.

### ART-3270 – Color and Light Photography

This intermediate course is designed to introduce students to color theory as it pertains to photography, the history of color within the photographic medium, and lighting techniques.

#### ART-3260 – Intermediate Darkroom Photography

This course builds upon the skills learned in earlier photography courses.

Defining personal voice, taking command of your artistic vision and practice, and developing a personal process of creative production are our main objective.

#### ART-3250 - Intro to Digital Photography

This course is an introduction to digital photography. Image creation occurs predominately with the camera, and various Digital technologies are used produce and convey our artistic endeavors.

### ART-3005 – Translation as Making

The course focuses on building a visual and conceptual means of expression and communication. Students work with the medium of their choice to respond to provided topics/prompts.

#### ART-2225 – Intro to Darkroom Photography

This course is an introduction to black and white darkroom photography and will build upon the foundation of techniques and practices developed in the survey section.

# ART-2220 – Photography Survey

This course introduces the multi-faceted medium of photography. Historical and contemporary uses of the medium are explored both intellectually and conversationally.

### ART-1014— Narrative in Art and Design

This course provides an introduction to the principles of visual narrative through various art

disciplines and media in 2d, 3d, and 4d.

### ART-1012- Form, Space, and Color

The students use the tools of sculpture, painting, and photography in their investigations of Form, space, and color.

## ART-1011 – Visual Organization

This course is designed to introduce the principles of visual organization through use of various media. Emphasis will be on developing thinking process, problem solving, practicing of good craftsmanship, and constructive criticism
